

RUNNING ELECTRIC CONTEST RULES (Winter 2020)

1. RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

No purchase is required in order to enter the Contest.

To be eligible to enter the *Running Electric Contest*, you must sign up at www.roulonselectrique.ca using the Contest registration form or during a test drive event organized as part of the Running Electric campaign when confirming your reservation on site. All entries must be submitted from a valid e-mail account.

By entering the Contest, you acknowledge that you have read the official Contest Rules and will comply with them.

There is a limit of one entry per person and per e-mail address for the duration of the Contest regardless of the number of e-mail addresses held by the contestant.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open exclusively to Canadian residents residing in the Province of Quebec who are 25 years of age or over on the Contest start date.

The Contest is open to the public from January 1, 2020, to March 31, 2020.

3. PROCEDURE FOR AWARDING PRIZE

After the Contest closes, a random draw will be held among all eligible entries received during the Contest period.

The contestant, randomly drawn, will win the Contest and receive an electric Chevrolet BOLT, for a rental of 12 months, courtesy of Gravel Auto as well as a FLO Home charging station (including installation) and an *Electric Circuit* access card (including 250\$ charging credit), subject to fulfillment of all of the conditions described in these rules.

The draw will be held by an Équiterre employee on April 8, 2020, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of Équiterre in Montreal, located at 50 Ste-Catherine Street West, Suite 340. The winner's name and photo may be published in one of Équiterre's publications or during an Équiterre event. The winner will be informed by e-mail on the week of the draw as to how to pick up the prize.



If the designated winner does not reply to Équiterre within 10 days of receiving this e-mail, Équiterre reserves the right to award the prize in question in another draw among the contestants.

4.1 DESCRIPTION OF PRIZES

The winner will receive:

- A one-year rental of a BOLT Chevrolet electric vehicle offered by Gravel Auto for a value of 10 000\$.
- A FLO Home charging station for electric vehicles, from the company **FLO**, including installation, up to a maximum value of \$2,500.
- A \$250 credit with the *Electric Circuit* public charging network.

The winner of the *Running Electric Contest* must hold a minimum Class 5 driver's licence, valid for the duration of the rental, that is, for one year as of the signing of the rental agreement. If the winner does not have a driver's licence, he or she will be deemed to have renounced the prize and another random draw will be held.

The approximate total value of these prizes is: 12 750\$

4.2 PRIZE PICK-UP

Once the winner has been chosen, he or she must provide certain information to our partners:

• Gravel Auto (Chevrolet BOLT electric vehicle)

With respect to the rental of the Chevrolet BOLT electric vehicle, the vehicle can be delivered directly to the winner's home, free of charge, if he or she does not live in Montreal City or the surrounding area. If the winner lives in Montreal City or the surrounding area, he or she must go to the Gravel Auto Île-des-Soeurs located at 1007 boulevard René Lévesque, Verdun, Québec, H3X 2J8.

The winner must sign a rental agreement that stipulates the proper use of the vehicle for the period in question. The winner will also receive information from the representative on how to operate and use the vehicle. Among other things, the winner needs to have an auto insurance that covers both sides, as much damage you could cause to others as damage to the vehicle loaned and including rider 27 (insurance that covers damages to a vehicle that is loaned or leased) so that the vehicle can be recovered and used during the negotiated period. Finally. Gravel Auto agrees to cover the costs of maintaining the vehicle in proper conditions during the period negotiated but the repair costs, if any, will be at the expense of the winner. (covered by his or her insurance).



Please note that the vehicle loaned to the winner by Gravel Auto will have to be exchanged for another equivalent Chevrolet BOLT before reaching 8,000 kilometres on the odometer. The winner will therefore have to make sure not to exceed the mileage mentioned above, or it will have to pay \$ 13,000 (the discount that can be obtained on a new electric vehicle that has less than 8,000 kilometres to the meter). Once close to 8,000 kilometres on the meter, the winner will have to get in touch with Gravel Auto and the latter agrees to exchange in store or have the winner deliver a new electric Chevrolet BOLT.

• **FLO** (home charging station)

To obtain the home charging station, the winner must provide the FLO company with his or her postal address and the station will be sent directly, free of charge. The cost of installation will be paid by Équiterre, up to a maximum of \$1,500. The installer must be a certified electrician, who will be required to send the invoice for the work directly to Équiterre's e-mail address: infos@roulonselectrique.ca. In the event that the installation of the charging station is not possible for various technical reasons, or that an agreement cannot be reached with the other tenants or group of owners, or that the costs exceed \$1,500, Équiterre will not provide, in cash, the value of the installation or will not assume any costs exceeding \$1,500.

• Electric Circuit (public charging credit)

The winner must provide the requested information by e-mail for the opening of an Electric Circuit account in his or her name (including \$250 charging credits). He or she will then receive an *Electric Circuit* card by post (but will have access to the public charging stations of the network as soon as the account is opened thanks to the *Electric Circuit* mobile application).

5. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- **5.1**. The prizes must be accepted as is and cannot be exchanged or redeemed for cash. No substitution of prizes is permitted. Any unused portion of a prize awarded, for whatever reason, will be forfeited.
- **5.2**. If it is not possible to provide one of the prizes exactly as described in these rules, the Contest organizers reserve the right to substitute a prize or prize component with another of approximately comparable value, at their sole discretion.
- **5.3**. Any false statement by a contestant will automatically entail his or her disqualification from the Contest.



- **5.4**. Équiterre (through one of its representatives) could, at its sole discretion, require proof of identity or age of a contestant. The refusal to provide the proof requested will automatically lead to the contestant's disqualification.
- **5.5**. The Contest organizers assume no liability for any loss, damage or bodily injury of any form, including but not limited to:
 - The loss, theft or damage to software or computer or telephone data, including any breach of privacy;
 - Fraudulent calls:
 - Inability of any person to participate in the Contest for any reason including mistaken addresses on mail or e-mail, technical, computer or telephone malfunctions or other problems with computer online systems, services, access providers, computer equipment, or software; entry forms that are lost, delivered late, incomplete, illegible or misdirected; bugs, service outages, transmission failures or losses due to equipment or software, late transmissions or compromises of data transmitted; congestion on the Internet or at any website, or any combination of the foregoing;
 - Damage to any person's computer, including as a result of playing or downloading any material relating to the Contest;
 - Loss, damage or misdirection of prizes during delivery;
 - Loss, damage, defects or inability to use the prize once awarded to the winner for any reason whatsoever.
- **5.6**. You agree that in your use of social media or other platforms for this contest, including, but not limited to, chat areas and the registration and use of social media accounts, user names or group names, you will not use obscene, libellous or slanderous language, or language that infringes upon a third party's trademark, trade name or other intellectual property right or right to privacy.
- **5.7**. If it is determined by Équiterre that a contestant tampers with or abuses any aspect of this contest, including but not limited to acting in violation of these rules, attempting to participate in the Contest more than the maximum number of times allowed, to be acting with the intent to disrupt the normal operation of this Contest, this contestant will be disqualified. Any contestant using robotic, automatic, programmed, third party or like methods to enter or try to enter the Contest will void any attempted entries effected by such methods and this person will be disqualified at Équiterre's sole and absolute discretion.
- **5.8**. Équiterre reserves the right to cancel or suspend this contest in its sole discretion for any reason including but not limited to corruption of the security or proper administration of the Contest as a result of a bug, virus, tampering or other causes. Any attempt to deliberately damage any website or to undermine the legitimate operation of this contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, Équiterre reserves the right to seek remedies and damages to the fullest extent permitted by law, including criminal prosecution.



- **5.9**. Personal information requested at the time of registration for the test drive is collected by Équiterre and used by Équiterre to contact the winner for the purposes of the Contest. Only participants who give their consent to receive communications from CAA-Quebec, Équiterre, the MIAS and certain car manufacturers will be able to receive these communications.
- **5.10**. If the identity of a contestant is disputed, the authorized holder of the e-mail address submitted at the time of entry will be deemed to be the contestant. The individual assigned to the e-mail address for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address is considered the authorized account holder. A randomly drawn contestant may be required to provide proof that he or she is the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the selected entry. **All entries must be submitted from a valid e-mail account.**
- **5.11**. By entering the Contest, contestants agree to abide by the Contest Rules and the decisions of Équiterre. In addition, the winner releases Équiterre from any liability for damages they may suffer as a result of taking possession of their prizes and waives any recourse or legal action against Équiterre.
- **5.12**. Entry into the Contest and the contestants' agreement to enter and abide by the Rules of the *Running Electric Contest* are governed by the laws of the Province of Quebec and federal laws of Canada applicable therein. By submitting their entry form, contestants agree to acknowledge the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Quebec.
